



HCPNA Board Meeting

December 5, 2007

Historic College Park Neighborhood Association Board Meeting Tom Fulkerson's home

Board members present: Kim Cline, Tom Fulkerson, Leslie Haskin, Noel Mayeske, Eileen Murphy, Phyllis Ray.

Board members absent: Robert Golden, Jane Randolph, Terry Lawler.

1. Tom: this year's holiday party, held 12.2.07 at the Feed Store, cost \$2,009.95. Last year we spent approximately \$1,300 at Manchester Arms. About 75 people attended this year's party, more than approximately 60 people last year.
2. Tom: we need to enter the new year with money-making events.
3. We discussed not having a Trees Atlanta planting in Spring because of the drought. But we could consider one for October if the drought improves.
4. Tom: would like to have a page in *Dogwoods and Sidewalks* for ads.
5. Kim: maybe charge \$25 for a quarter-page ad?
6. Tom: will call Stephanie Murphy to see if she will sell ads for us.
7. Kim: start low with the ad cost, to get people into it. Then maybe raise rates later.
8. Kim: will check out what the price would be to add a 2-page insert or a full 4 additional pages to *Dogwoods and Sidewalks*.
9. Tom: focus on the plant sale as a money-maker, and sell food to make money as well at the sale. Maybe move it from the Women's Club to Barrett Park. Eileen: it may not be very successful this year because of the drought.
10. Tom: we need to have as many citizens as possible to attend the Dec. 17 City Council meeting. Alan and Linda Gravitt were recently trying to speak before the council to give a report on Charles Phillips' ethics violations. He is accused of using city funds to pay for his campaign. Alan and Linda were voted 2-1 by council to not be able to speak. They were physically removed from the premises.
11. Eileen: membership report. Of 198 members, we have 76 renewals so far.
12. Tom: we have approximately \$2,500-\$3,000 balance currently; need to verify with Robert.
